We will not pay more than 100% of the face amount for all covered critical illnesses combined. The policy will terminate when the maximum benefit amount for specified critical illness has been paid.

EXCLUSIONS AND LIMITATIONS FOR SPECIFIED CRITICAL ILLNESS

We will not pay benefits for a specified critical illness that occurs as a result of a covered person's: alcoholism or drug addiction; felonies or illegal occupations; intoxicants and narcotics; psychiatric or psychological condition; suicide or self-inflicted injuries; or war or armed conflict.
